Welcome to a new season at Sunscape! More events and activities are being added to the calendar on a daily basis. If you are just getting here, please sign in at the Welcome Center and update your information. This will get you signed up to receive mail at Sunscape. This also provides the park with a phone number to call in case of an emergency. If you have renters coming in this season, please let the Welcome Center know. All occupied lots must have at least one person age 55 or older staying on it. Sunscape is required by Pinal County to keep a copy of your dog's rabies vaccination papers and to document all travel trailers present in the park. Any travel trailer (including fifth wheels) staying longer than six months is required to pay property tax in Arizona. Friday, October 13th we will be having a Start of Season Pizza Party at 5 p.m. on the patio. \$8 for all-you-can-eat pizza, lemonade and tea. Napkins, glasses and plates included. Need a minimum of 35 to sign up in the CH by Wednesday, October 11th or the vendor will not come.

Sunday, October 15th the first Sunscape Christian Fellowship services of the season will be held at 8:50 a.m. in the CC with Pastor Fred.

Sunday, October 15th is the first day for Sunscape Café meals. Full information at end of Activity Sheet

Tuesday, October 17th there will be a meeting in the CH at 1 pm for all who are interested in playing darts. We will discuss what dart boards we want to purchase. There is money in the budget to buy a couple this year but the decision on machines needs to be made soon so the funds can be requested in the 2018 budget.

Wednesday, October 18th is the date for the first ice cream social of the season! Ice cream varieties available are reduced fat varieties of chocolate, chocolate revel, vanilla and strawberry revel. Regular, sugar free and reduced fat toppings available. \$1 a scoop, \$3 for a root beer float and \$4 for a banana split. Ice cream will be scooped from 3:00 to 3:30 p.m.

Thursday, October 19th Walgreens will have an Immunization clinic here from 10 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Vaccines available are Influenza – regular and high dose, Pneumococcal Polysaccharide (pneumonia), Td (Tetanus-Diphtheria) and Tdap (tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis). Shingles and Hepatitis B vaccines are available – please indicate this on signup sheet as Walgreens will not bring them unless requested. Medicare covers flu shots 100% and Walgreens will take care of the paperwork. Get a shot and stay for the first Sunscape Café lunch of the season. Sign up in CH. Information sheets on shots are located on the table by the Activity Office door.

Tuesday, November 7th join the group for the 7 p.m. performance of Kiss and Tell at the Hale Centre Theatre. Hugh Herbert's 1940's riotous romp entangles a family feud, a secret marriage, and a madcap dose of mistaken identity! Architectural Committee

Beginning October 18th the Architectural committee will meet on the first and third Wednesdays of each month at 1:00 pm in the Activity Center Conference Room. If you have a request for a permit please sign up on the sheet provided outside of the room on the day of the meeting. Please use the Project Layout form, available at the Welcome Center, to show the work you are proposing. Copies of the Architecture Rules are also available at the Welcome Center.

Many of you requested permits last spring for projects that were going to be completed during the summer. If you have completed your project please return the pink "Project Completion" form to the Welcome Center. If your project completion is delayed, please let us know so that we can extend the completion date.

There have been changes to our emergency notification system. The universal emergency number is 9-1-1. It is recommended that 9-1-1 be deferred to as the emergency number and residents should no longer call 421-9957 for an emergency. However, those situations that are NOT an emergency, such as a suspected bee hive, snake removal, vehicle or home lock out, lift assist or other similar situations, should be directed to (520)421-9957. Whether a resident calls the (520)421-9957 number or 911, they will ultimately reach the same person at the same location (ambulance and fire dispatcher in Glendale, AZ).

Our mail boxes are small and the mail personnel frequently have problems getting all of a person's mail into the box. Cut down on your junk mail by opting out via the Direct Marketing Association. Register on their website, www.dmachoice.org. It's free and they'll remove you from 75% of all junk mail lists.

Any ads on the breezeway corkboard not dated by the Park Manager or Activity Director in the last six months will be removed on November 1st.

Paper goes in the paper dumpsters. Sunscape benefits when you recycle!
